## Action 1: Doctors Against Genocide letters for Dr. Hussam Abu Safiya

- This week, we are supporting Doctors Against Genocide's letter-writing campaign by sending emails to the White House and Congress demanding the immediate release of Dr. Hussam Abu Safiya and other healthcare worker hostages illegally detained by Israel. Online letters are much stronger when you personalize your subject line (not available for this campaign) and the beginning of your letter text. Click here to send a letter.

- Artist Feature: <u>Sol Band</u>, a musical group formed in Gaza in 2012, plays both traditional Arabic music and their own modern pop songs all around the world. Music has always been a refuge of sorts for the seven members, but during the months they spent in Gaza before they were <u>forced to evacuate</u> in April 2024, music was especially useful for cultivating hope, even as they <u>performed and recorded</u> in the rubble and amidst continued bombardment.

## Action 2: Call Congress to End Weapons Transfers to Israel & Denounce Torture

## **Script for Calling**

My name is [YOUR FIRST & LAST NAME] and I'm a constituent of [REPRESENTATIVE/ SENATOR NAME]. I'm calling today to ask that [REPRESENTATIVE/ SENATOR NAME] in the new year, call for an immediate cease-fire, arms embargo, and full funding for humanitarian aid. Today, I'm particularly concerned about the abuse and torture of Palestinian prisoners in Israeli detention facilities.

In the new year, while many are trying to turn over a new leaf, Israeli airstrikes, many with US munitions, continue to kill Palestinians in the hundreds each week. Just today, around 100 Palestinians have been killed. But it is not just Israeli airstrikes that are killing Palestinians, the number of identified detainees from Gaza who have died in Israeli custody is 35.

As of December 2024, according to data provided by the Israel Prison Service (IPS) to Hamoked, an Israeli human rights NGO, there are 10,154 Palestinians in Israeli custody, including 2,003 sentenced prisoners, 2,951 remand detainees, 3,428 administrative detainees held without trial, and 1,772 people held as "unlawful combatants." These figures do not include Palestinians from Gaza who have been detained by the Israeli military since 7 October 2023 and their number remains unknown.

I urge [REPRESENTATIVE/ SENATOR] to do whatever they can in 2025 the new year to bring about a permanent cease-fire, an arms embargo on Israel, and a refunding of UNRWA. During the holiday season, we are reminded that every life is sacred and our actions must match this fundamental truth. Every life taken is one too many.
